The implementation of the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2018* (PID Act) establishes a scheme that facilitates the appropriate disclosure of public interest information and provides protection for public officers who make an appropriate disclosure.

SAPOL's Public Interest Disclosure Procedure sets out the procedures for making, receiving, assessing, storing, and informing and protecting informants who make appropriate disclosures of public interest information.

SAPOL's compliance with the requirements of the PID Act promote transparency and accountability across the organisation that demonstrates our commitment to living our organisational values, and building on the high level of trust and confidence the community has in us and the services we deliver.
