Summary: At about 1845hrs on 13/04/2022 at Beach Road, CHRISTIES BEACH, suspect ⁶⁽¹⁾ was in possession of a large sword waving it at traffic. Police attended and located ⁶⁽¹⁾ who removed a sword from his pants. Police directed ⁶⁽¹⁾ to drop the sword and after a short period of time he complied. Suspect was arrested and placed in rear of police cage S303-BQA (385) when he headbutted the front perplex causing the external glass to crack. Witnesses / CCTV footage available.

ACTION AT SCENE

At about 1845hrs on 13/04/2022, Police (BROWN / BUDICH-BRAIN) were tasked to Beach Road, CHRISTIES BEACH pertaining to a sighting of a male with a large sword.

At this time Police located suspect ⁶⁽¹⁾ crossing Beach road from the northern footpath walking towards the southern footpath. ⁶⁽¹⁾ was standing on Beach Road when Police directed him to the southern footpath. At this time ⁶⁽¹⁾ removed a sword from his pants and held it by his side. Police directed ⁶⁽¹⁾ to drop the sword and after a short period of time he complied.

Suspect was arrested and placed in rear of police cage S303-BQA (385) when he head-butted the front perplex causing the external glass to crack. Witnesses / CCTV footage available.

Various Police attended at the time of the offence. Subsequently ⁶⁽¹⁾ as a result of this matter was transferred to FMC by SAAS for a psych assessment.
