Re: Freedom of Information Act application

In reference to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991, access was sought to:

"Please provide the number and dollar amount of speeding infringement notices issued for the following schedule of locations from May 31 2017 to December 31 2017. If possible please include the speed bracket (in term of 1-10kmh over, 11-20kmh over etc) and the top speed in each of those areas, the number of days that a speed camera was in that location for the year and the number per weekday. This is similar to a previous FOI request your ref: SK1772

In relation to Part 1 of your request:

“Please provide the number and dollar amount of speeding infringement notices issued for the following schedule of locations from May 31 2017 to December 31 2017. If possible please include the speed bracket (in term of 1-10kmh over, 11-20kmh over etc) and the top speed in each of those areas,

It is determined to **refuse access** to this data pursuant to s20(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information Act 1991 which relevantly states:-

“An agency may refuse access to a document if it is a document that is available for inspection at that or some other agency (whether as part of a public register or otherwise) in accordance with Part 2, or in accordance with a legislative instrument other than this Act, whether or not inspection of the document is subject to a fee or charge;”

Please note that as of July 2014 Expiation Notice Data sets have been published on SA Government Open Data website which can be located at www.data.sa.gov.au/. The Expiation Notice System data covers financial years commencing 2011/2012 up to and including data for this financial year, providing statistical information on volumes of expiation notice offences processed for a rolling calendar year. For information, mobile speed camera data is available on that SA Government Open Data website.

Data that falls within the scope of your request is published and can be found at; <https://data.sa.gov.au/data/dataset/expiation-notice-system-data>. At the bottom of that page you will find a tab “*Mobile Camera Location Codes*” for the mobile camera location codes to identify the road and suburb.

Once you have the relevant code numbers for the locations you have nominated, you can peruse the data from the SA Government Open Data website for each financial year and you will see that *Column S* identifies the camera category (mobile or fixed) and *Column Z* identifies the mobile camera location codes. *Column J* identifies the “Expiation Offence by Long Description” that shows the bracket of offence speeds by 10 km/h increments. *Column P* identifies the offending vehicle speeds to enable you to locate the highest speeds in the areas you have nominated.

In relation to Part 2 of your request:

“.....the number of days that a speed camera was in that location for the year and the number per weekday.”

It is determined to **release in full** the number of days a speed camera was deployed for the schedule of locations from May 31 2017 to December 31 2017 as represented in the table below. These figures were accurate as at 24 January 2018.


Please note the zero deployments equates to the fact that speed camera's did not work on that road at the dates within scope.

Your rights to review and appeal

If you are dissatisfied with the determination for access to SAPOL records, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form (available upon request at your nearest police station), or an application may be made in writing to SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$34.25. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.
