**Re: Freedom of Information Act application**

In reference to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 1991, access was sought to:

Please also include second jobs that were refused. In the past when we've applied for this information, we've been provided a list of jobs and the number of officers doing them. If that exists, we'd be happy to limit to only that, along with a list of jobs that officers applied to do (as a second job) or were already doing which did not have the consent of the agency, or were refused permission. Please exclude duplicates, documents that have already been publicly released, media statements/reports/articles and correspondence with media. I consent to documents/video beings released with exempt material redacted/pixilated. I don't consent to documents being deemed irrelevant without consultation, but I do consent to being provided edited copies of documents/photos/footage with personal information redacted/pixilated.."*
