Thanks for your time on the phone earlier today, I really appreciate the call back.

As discussed, AOSMA is quite keen to have the matter at hand heard by the CBS Commissioner sooner rather than later. I must admit my understanding was that the matter was going to be heard last Monday the 27 June, but now understand it will be heard on 26 July.

At the AOSMA Board meeting today, I undertook to try and work with both SAPOL (as the only objector) and CBS to see if we can have this date moved up so that the AFL fans can benefit from this positive change this year.

By way of background, we have actively consulted with all Adelaide Oval venue hirer stakeholders including, SACA, SANFL, AFL Clubs, AFL and CA who are all in favour of the change. Further, the application has been supported by Deputy Premier Hon. Susan Close MP from an environmental and patron experience perspective (see attached), and the application has not been objected to by Adelaide City Councill, any local resident or private person.

That said, we are keen to understand all points of view and respect the process which we are not trying to circumvent, but to just have it dealt with sooner rather than later.



Over the weekend I was pleased to learn the Melbourne Cricket Ground is currently undertaking a trial of serving alcoholic beverages to customers in cans, rather than in plastic cups, in a move to reduce the venue's environmental footprint.
