**Re: Application for access to South Australia Police records**

I refer to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991 in which access was sought to the following information:

*"Documents, since 1 January, 2017, specifically incident/event reports, CCTV/body-worn camera/dashcam/video footage of police/Government property that has been or is in the process of being vandalised or stolen. For example, speed cameras - see link <http://www.adelaidenow.com.au/news/south-australia/revhead-aaron-goods-allegedly-went-on-vandalism-spree-damaging-22-speed-cameras/news-story/8aa169f28ef3705a66fcab765804a2fd?nk=85a84e0df0d81b5ef5dcbad0bc38c30f-1524026913>. Please also include ministerial/executive briefings, reports relating to annual cost of repairs to police/Government property has been vandalised or stolen. If more than 10 incidents are caught on camera, please limit to the first 10 where footage is located. Please exclude duplicates, documents that have already been publicly released, media reports/articles/releases and correspondence with media. Please exclude personal affairs information."*

In my letter dated 23 April 2018 I requested you narrow the scope of your request in accordance with section 18 of the FOI Act 1991. You narrowed the scope to, *"I would be happy for searches to be limited to just that – ie by charge that is laid when a person damages police property, and the records that facilitate the repair/replacement of the damage/vandalised police property."*

In my letter dated 8 May 2018 and following preliminary searches by my office, I requested you further narrow the scope in accordance with section 18 of the FOI Act 1991. You narrowed the scope to, *"...damaged /vandalised police property...a random selection of 10 Police Incident Reports to search for any video footage"*.



It is important to clarify that no CCTV or video footage was located despite the fact that the 'NARRATIVE' in document 4 states "CCTV footage available". Still images were discovered with documents 9, 10 and 11 and in keeping with the spirit of the FOI Act I have dealt with the still images in this determination.

It is important to draw your attention to the page numbers on the top right corner of each document. The page numbers relate to the number of pages printed with each batch print run and are not indicative of the number of pages associated with each report.

SAPOL has located documents that are associated with the wording of your FOI application. The documents are numbered and described in the following schedule. The schedule contains the details of the determination in compliance with section 23. In particular, note the grounds on which access has been refused, including the reasons which are contained in the schedule.

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#### **CLAUSES FOR REFUSAL**

Clause 4(1)(b) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

*"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to prejudice the fair trial of any person or the impartial adjudication of any case."*

Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

*"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."*

Clause 6(2) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

*"A document is an exempt document if it contains allegations or suggestions of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of a person (living or dead) the truth of which has not been established by judicial process and the disclosure of which would be unreasonable."*

In accordance with the requirements of Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045, details of your FOI application, and the documents to which you are given access, will be published on the SAPOL website Disclosure Log. A copy of PC045 can be found at <http://dpc.sa.gov.au/what-we-do/services-for-government/premier-and-cabinet-circulars>. If you disagree with publication, please advise the undersigned in writing by 30 July 2018.

#### **Your rights to review and appeal**

If you are dissatisfied with the determination for access to SAPOL records, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form which can be downloaded from <https://www.police.sa.gov.au/services-and-events/freedom-of-information> or available upon request at your nearest police station.

Alternatively an application may be made in writing to the SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This application must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$34.25. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.
