### Re: Freedom of Information Act application

I refer to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991 in which access was sought to the following information:

"Documents, specifically reports briefings and attachments and photos and CCTV/video, relating to charges laid or warnings/cautions as a result of weapons that occurred at SA educational facilities since 1 January, 2017. If the statistical information is available, please limit to just the statistical information and incident/event reports from just primary schools or childcare facilities in the Eastern, Northern, Western, Southern districts. If there are more than 50, please limit to the first 50 located. If weapons have to be named, please limit searches to firearm/gun, knife/knives, nun-chucks, weapons, knuckledusters, tasers, machetes, bayonets. Please exclude duplicates, already been publicly released. media documents that have statements/reports/articles and correspondence with media. I consent to released with exempt material documents/video beings (sic) redacted/pixilated."

On 17 September 2018, I sent you an email advising that preliminary enquiries had been made and South Australia Police (SAPOL) computer systems do not differentiate between primary and secondary schools for offences. I also asked for you to narrow the scope of your request. On 18 September 2018, you replied by email stating, "I'm fine with all the stats schools and the childcare/kindergarten, but I would want all the reports for the latter..."

Several reports were located on the SAPOL computer systems with the offence location of "school" however it is imperative to point out that these offences did not necessarily involve students or staff from that school and may have occurred outside normal school hours or days.



### In relation to this part of your request:

"...I'm fine with all the stats ..... childcare/kindergarten..."

It is determined to **release in full** the statistical information regarding offences where a weapon was involved and the location was listed as childcare / kindergarten from 1 January 2017. This information is contained within the table below and was correct as of 16 September 2018.

The page numbers relate to the number of pages printed with each batch print run and are not indicative of the number of pages associated with each report.

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located documents that are associated with the wording of your FOI application. The documents are numbered and described in the following schedule. The schedule contains the details of the determination in compliance with section 23. In particular, note the grounds on which access has been refused, including the reasons which are contained in the schedule.

The following factors were considered as to whether or not it would be unreasonable to disclose those personal affairs:

- I have turned my mind to section 14 of the Victims of Crime Act 2001 – Protection of Privacy – there should be no unnecessary intrusion on a victims privacy;
- The Police Report Number together with the reported date would disclose the status of the investigation via 'Track My Crime' which is available on line as a service for victims of crime on the SAPOL website;
- The very nature of the information would disclose the personal affairs of third parties and identify them as being victims of crime, reporting persons, witnesses and suspects;
- It was considered improbable that the personal affairs of the third parties are already in the public domain;
- There is a strong public interest in protecting an individual's privacy, including the third parties;
- There is a potential for the document to be disseminated to other parties.

Clause 6(2) – relates to document number 2.
It has been considered and the

view formed is that a portion of text within these documents are allegations of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of the third parties other than Ms Allison Sandy; the truth of which has not been established by judicial process.

The following factors were considered as to whether or not it would be unreasonable to disclose those personal affairs:

- The fact is that allegations of criminal conduct are recorded against multiple third parties and the truth of those allegations has not been established by judicial process;
- The very nature of the information would disclose the identity of the third parties and the fact they were a suspect for alleged criminal offences, the truth of which has not been established by judicial process;
- It was considered improbable that allegations of the third parties being nominated as suspects would be in the public domain; and
- There is a potential for the document to be disseminated to other parties.

# <u>Clause 6(3a)</u> – relates to document number 2.

It is fact that the documents contain information concerning third parties who are presently, or at the time of making the report were, under the age of 18 years.

The following factors were considered as to whether or not it would be unreasonable to disclose those personal affairs having regard to the need to protect that person's welfare:

	<ul> <li>The third parties are extremely vulnerable persons whether it be their young age, impairment of cognitive development or degree of understanding;</li> <li>A child or young person's mental and physical health and wellbeing as well as safety is of paramount concern to SAPOL.</li> </ul>
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### **CLAUSES FOR REFUSAL**

Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."

Clause 6(2) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains allegations or suggestions of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of a person (living or dead) the truth of which has not been established by judicial process and the disclosure of which would be unreasonable."

Clause 6(3a) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter consisting of information concerning a person who is presently under the age of 18 years or suffering from mental illness, impairment or infirmity or concerning such a person's family or circumstances, or information of any kind furnished by a person who was under that age or suffering from mental illness, impairment or infirmity when the information was furnished and the disclosure of which would be unreasonable having regard to the need to protect that person's welfare."
