



SENIOR ROAD USER Road Safety Sessions

The SA Police Road Safety Centre is a leader in road safety education and contributes to a reduction in the frequency and severity of road trauma in South Australia.

Staying safe on the road is important for all drivers, however as we get older we change physically and mentally, which can affect our driving skills.

The Road Safety Centre offers free road safety presentations to older road users, anywhere in the State.

Senior Road Users

(60 Minutes)

The presentation addresses issues faced by senior road users (drivers and pedestrians), including the increased risk of physical injury, the effects of prescription medications, night driving and alternative strategies. The session contains a road rule refresher as well as looking at the crash statistics of the 60+ age group. The 'fatal five' is also covered.

Mobility Scooters

(60 Minutes)

This presentation covers the legal requirements and the safety considerations of using motorised wheelchairs on the road. The 'fatal five' is also discussed.
