## PASSENGER SAFETY



When you are a passenger:

- make sure your seatbelt straps are snug
- never wriggle out of your seatbelt
- always leave your seatbelt on until the car has stopped
- a good passenger always talks quietly and doesn't distract the driver.

Remember, always use the safety door (on the footpath side) when getting out of the car.

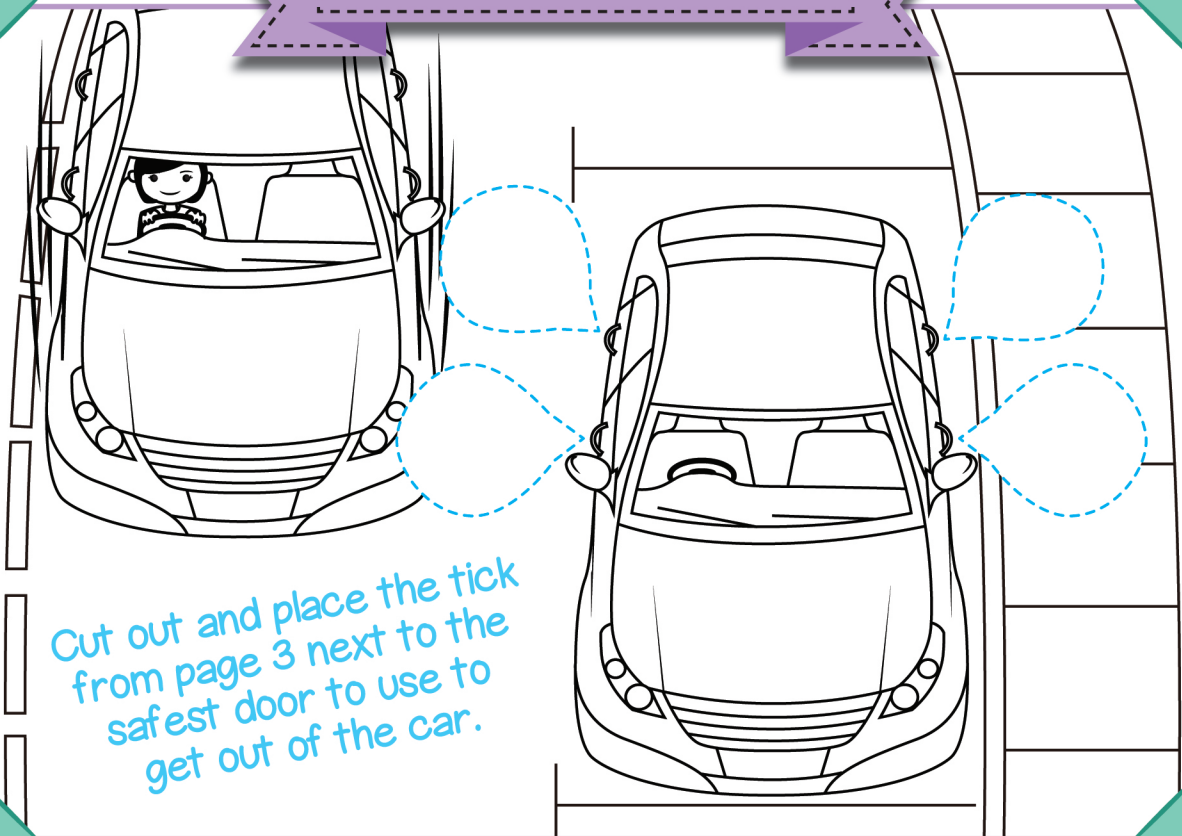
