Re: Freedom of Information Act application

I refer to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991 in which access was sought to the following information:

"Documents since 1 January, 2017, specifically reports, statistics, audits, executive meeting minutes, CCTV/body worn camera/dash cam/video footage and photos and internal correspondence relating to stolen firearms. Along with CCTV/body worn camera/dash cam/video footage and photos, I'm specifically seeking documents with the following information:

Total number of licensed firearms reported stolen to police this year and last year (mutually exclusive please)?

What are the dates and locations (limit to City, or if it's not a city, region) this year.

Were the licensed firearms reportedly stolen from residential or commercial premises?

How many of those reported stolen licensed firearms were unsecured?

How many media releases were put out concerning reported stolen licensed firearms?

Please exclude duplicates, documents that have already been publicly released include media reports/statements/articles and correspondence with media."

On 21 December 2018, I invited you by email to narrow the scope of your request. You replied on 2 January 2019 via email: *"I'm happy to go with statistics for 2017 and 2018 with just the number and breakdown of LAC's. However I'll need some context so request the incident reports for the metropolitan LAC's. If that's too many then I'm happy to name specific LAC's."*

On 3 January 2019, I telephoned you and you agreed to further narrow the scope of your request to only include the Police Incident Reports from the Eastern Police District and the Northern Police District.



In relation to the following part of your request:

"statistics for 2017 and 2018 with just the number and breakdown of LAC's..."

It is determined to **release in full** the statistics for total number of firearm thefts reported to Police for the financial years 2016/17 2017/18 and 2018/19. This data is contained within the table below and was correct as at 31 December 2018.

Please note:

- 'Unsecured' refers to firearms which have been left in the open where access could have been obtained by anyone. 'Secured' refers to firearms which were intentionally secured by the owner to any level of security or vehicle.

Clause 11(b) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:


"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter prepared for the purposes of proceedings (including any transcript of the proceedings) that are being heard or are to be heard before a court or tribunal."


