

SOUTH AUSTRALIA POLICE – ANNUAL REPORTING 2018-19

Regional Impact Assessment Statements

As required by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet Circular No.13 Annual Reporting Requirements and the Regional Impact Assessment Statements policy for South Australian government agencies, departments and agencies and statutory authorities are required to prepare and publish Regional Impact Assessment Statements prior to implementing significant changes to existing government services to rural and regional areas.

One Regional Impact Assessment Statement (RIAS) was prepared during 2018-19 relating to the Wirrabara Police Station, relocating the police position to Gladstone as a second in charge position due to the poor condition of the police station making it uninhabitable. This RIAS was approved and actioned. Key stakeholders were engaged and a public information session was held. The Wirrabara police position was relocated to Gladstone as a second in charge position on a temporary basis until the future of the Wirrabara police site is known.



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
