**Re: Application for access to South Australia Police records**

I refer to your application received by South Australia Police (SAPOL) in which access was sought to the following information:

*"Documents from July 1, 2018 (the past financial year 2018/19) showing the top 10 mobile speed camera locations by infringements issued each year including the following:*

- 1. The location;*
- 2. The number of infringements issued;*
- 3. The speeding category (eg. 10km or more over the limit; 20km or more over the limit, etc...)*

*Please include footage of the top 10 fastest people speeding caught on camera...Please note, I consent to being provided edited copies of documents/footage/photos with exempt material (such as personal details) redacted/pixelated."*

**In relation to Parts One, Two & Three of your request:**

*"Documents from July 1, 2018 (the past financial year 2018/19) showing the top 10 mobile speed camera locations by infringements issued each year including the following: 1. The location;  
2. The number of infringements issued;  
3. The speeding category (eg. 10km or more over the limit; 20km or more over the limit, etc...) ..."*

It is determined to **refuse access** to this data pursuant to s20(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information Act 1991 which relevantly states:-

*"An agency may refuse access to a document if it is a document that is available for inspection at that or some other agency (whether as part of a public register or otherwise) in accordance with Part 2, or in accordance with a legislative*

*instrument other than this Act, whether or not inspection of the document is subject to a fee or charge.”*

Please note that as of July 2014 Expiation Notice Data sets have been published on SA Government Open Data website.

Data that falls within the scope of your request is published and can be found at <https://data.sa.gov.au/data/dataset/expiation-notice-system-data>.

On perusal of the Expiation Notice Data sets you will see that the ‘*Mobile camera location code*’ is under *Column Z*. The location codes can be found at <https://data.sa.gov.au/data/dataset/f8647df4-617b-439c-8de2-6aadfc84826a/resource/892be609-41b7-4923-b0d8-da456da0357f/download/mobilecameracodes.csv>.

**In relation to the following part of your request:**

*“...Please include footage of the top 10 fastest people speeding caught on camera...Please note, I consent to being provided edited copies of documents/footage/photos with exempt material (such as personal details) redacted/pixilated.”*

SAPOL has located documents that fall within the scope of your request. The documents are numbered and described in the following schedule. The schedule contains details of the determination in compliance with section 23.

It is noted that you sought to have personal details removed from photographs and in line with your request, SAPOL Expiation Notice Branch provided, copies of images to FOI Unit with the registration number of each vehicle redacted. Please note that images are the best quality SAPOL can produce for the purpose of this determination. You will note that depending on the time of day the images were taken, some are darker than others. This determination was made on 18 November 2019.



Your rights to review

If you are dissatisfied with the determination for access to SAPOL records, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form which can be downloaded from <https://www.police.sa.gov.au/services-and-events/freedom-of-information> or available upon request at your nearest police station. Alternatively an application may be made in writing to the SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This application must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$36.75. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.
