"...Were the licenced firearms reportedly stolen from residential or commercial premises?..."

It is determined to **release in full** data that falls within this part of your request. The data was correct as at 3 December 2020.

When interpreting the data please note data is regarding licenced firearm holders reporting stolen firearms. For the financial year 2018/2019 eight (8) firearms were stolen from commercial premises and one hundred and seventy (170) were stolen from residential premises. For the financial year 2019/2020 two (2) firearms were stolen from commercial premises and one hundred and nineteen (119) were stolen from residential premises.

### In relation to the following part of your request:

"...How many of these reported licensed firearms were unsecured?..."

It is determined to **release in full** data that falls within this part of your request was correct as at 3 December 2020.

When interpreting the data please note data regarding firearms not secured in accordance with the Code of Practice 35(3) South Australian Firearms Act, 2015. For the financial year 2018/2019 four (4) firearms were insecure and for the financial year 2019/2020 three (3) firearms were insecure.

# In relation to the following part of your request:

"...And related AV material – up to five video clips. If footage isn't capture, photos please."

No documents that fall within the scope of your request could be located.
