People arriving from ACT or NSW

People (including SA residents, People Passing Through SA, NSW Cross Border Community Members (except for emergency medical care) and those relocating to SA) who have been in ACT or NSW within the last 14 days	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. SA Residents, NSW Cross Border Community Members or those relocating to SA can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel.
People who are escaping Domestic Violence or Commonwealth MPs and their staff who have been in ACT or NSW within the last 14 days (including as a transiting passenger through Sydney Airport)	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine at a place determined by an authorised officer for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
Commonwealth MPs and their staff who have been in ACT during the past 14 days (excluding anyone who has transited through Sydney Airport)	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
Essential Travellers having been in ACT or NSW within the last 14 days	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Essential travellers from ACT or NSW have level 4 requirements. Please refer to the Essential traveller Table for more information.

People arriving from VIC

Any person who has been in Victoria within the last 14 days (including Returning SA Residents, People Passing Through SA and Genuine Relocations)	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. SA Residents or those relocating to SA can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel.
People who are escaping Domestic Violence who have been in Victoria within the last 14 days	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine at a place determined by an authorised officer for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
Essential Travellers who have been anywhere in Victoria within the last 14 days	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.

People arriving from QLD

People (including Permitted Arrivals and Essential Travellers) who have been in the LGAs of City of Brisbane, City of Gold Coast, Moreton Bay Regional Council and Logan City arriving in SA who in the 14 days prior to their arrival (but not before 17 September 2021)	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine until negative test. No entry into high risk setting for 14 days after arrival, unless clause 9 applies. No entry to COVID Management Plan events >1000 attendees
People arriving from any other area of Queensland	No Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are arriving from any other area of Queensland are not subject to any restrictions upon entering SA.

People arriving from NT, TAS or WA

People arriving from Northern Territory, Tasmania or Western Australia	No Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are arriving from, Northern Territory, Tasmania, or Western Australia are not subject to any restrictions upon entering SA, provided they have not been in a restricted zone in the 14 days prior to entering SA.

Transiting through another state to get to SA

Transiting through an Airport (excluding Sydney Airport)	No Level	<p>A domestic traveller is permitted to transit through an airport provided;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The person has travelled via the most direct and practical route. They wear a face mask for the entire time. They do not leave the airport before boarding their onward flight.
Transiting through NSW (including Sydney Airport) from an unrestricted location	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. <p>NOTE: Travellers from VIC, NSW, and ACT are still subject to Level 6 requirements (unless an exemption has been granted from an authorised officer).</p>
