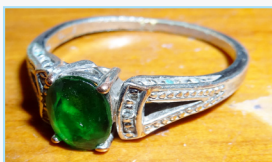

HELP FIND YOUR STOLEN PROPERTY

Thieves use a variety of methods to sell stolen property including online trading websites.

You can recognise your own property quicker than someone who is not familiar with the items.

Police encourage you to search popular websites where your property may be placed for sale.

If you are able to identify your property contact Police on **131444** and quote your Police report number.

Prevent thieves stealing your property

- Use keyed locks on doors and windows. Install and activate an alarm.
- Remove all valuables from your vehicle.
- Photograph, engrave or mark valuables with your driver's licence number prefixed with 'S' for South Australia. Record the make, model and serial number.
