Dear Mr Dally-Watkins,

Re: Freedom of Information Act application

I refer to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991 in which access was sought to the following information:

"Documents, specifically body-worn camera footage / taser cam / dash cam / CCTV / video footage and related reports since 1 January, 2017, to the date of this application relating to reports where the charge was at least weapons trafficking ie. There could be more charges, but there is at least one charge for weapons trafficking.

If more than 10 where this is the case, please limit to the first 10 (starting oldest to newest) where footage/photos are located and there is no pending legal action. Please exclude duplicates, documents that have already been publicly released, media report/articles/releases and correspondence with media. If documents with duplicate information are captured, please limit to just one version of those documents. I confirm I consent to being provided edited copies of documents/footage with personal information such as names and faces redacted/pixilated/blurred."

Before dealing with your request it is important to draw your attention to the page numbers on the top right corner of each document. The page numbers relate to the number of pages printed with each batch print run and are not indicative of the number of pages associated with each report.

I confirm that searches were undertaken for CCTV and video footage however no documents were located.

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located documents that are associated with the wording of your FOI application. The documents are numbered and described in the following schedule. The schedule contains the details of the determination in compliance with section 23. In particular, note the grounds on which access has been refused, including the reasons which are contained in the schedule.

A number of exempt personal affairs are clear on the face of the document however others are not. The exempt personal affairs on each document includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name; • Home and mobile; telephone number; • Ethnicity; • Primary Language spoken; • Residency status; • Home Address; • Work Address; • Occupation; • Offence location; • Personal description details; <p>The following factors were considered as to whether or not it would be unreasonable to disclose those personal affairs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The very nature of the information would disclose the personal affairs of third parties and identify them as suspects; • It was considered improbable that the personal affairs of the third parties are already in the public domain; • There is a strong public interest in protecting an individual's privacy, including the third parties; • There is a potential for the document to be disseminated to other parties.

			<p>Clause 6(2)</p> <p>It has been considered and the view formed is that a portion of text within these documents are allegations of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of the third parties other than Mr Charlie Dally-Watkins; the truth of which has not been established by judicial process.</p> <p>The following factors were considered as to whether or not it would be unreasonable to disclose those personal affairs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>The fact is that allegations of criminal conduct are recorded and the truth of those allegations has not been established by judicial process;</i> • <i>The very nature of the information would disclose the identity of the third parties and the fact they were a suspect for alleged criminal offences, the truth of which has not been established by judicial process;</i> • <i>It was considered improbable that allegations of the third parties being nominated as suspects would be in the public domain; and</i> • <i>There is a potential for the document to be disseminated to other parties.</i>

CLAUSES FOR REFUSAL

Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."


Clause 6(2) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains allegations or suggestions of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of a person (living or dead) the truth of which has not been established by judicial process and the disclosure of which would be unreasonable."

Your rights to review and appeal

If you are dissatisfied with the determination for access to SAPOL records, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form which can be downloaded from <https://www.police.sa.gov.au/services-and-events/freedom-of-information> or available upon request at your nearest police station. Alternatively an application may be made in writing to the SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This application must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$35.00. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.

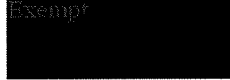

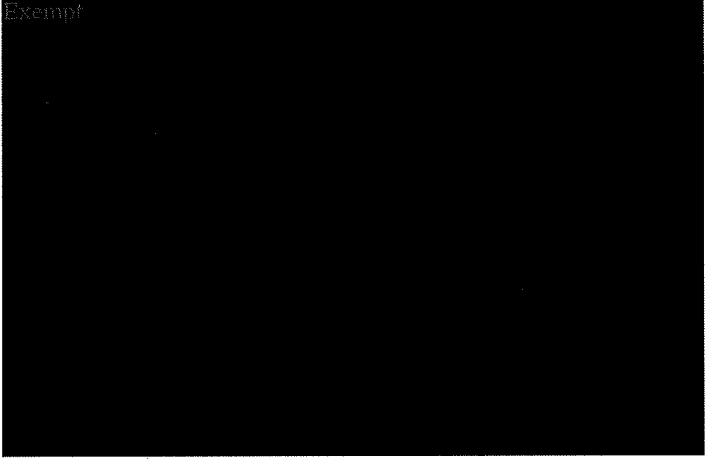
