* For those wishing to apply on vocals or a rhythm section instrument (i.e. piano, bass, drums or guitar), it would be an advantage to demonstrate learning on a brass or woodwind instrument or percussion as well.

Students are urged to apply early due to restrictions on the number of placements. Applications are assessed by SAPOL Band members in consultation with the student's instrumental/classroom teachers. Those meeting the minimum standards are approved on a first come, first served basis.
