



Traveller Requirements for Entry into SA

Residents of SA travelling to VIC and then returning to SA

Residents of VIC

National and State Security and Governance

- COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, &12
- No quarantine
- Written approval from manager

- COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, &12
- Quarantine when not working
- Written approval from manager

Emergency Service Workers

- No test
- No quarantine
- Mask for 14 days when in contact with the public

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Commercial Transport and Freight Services

- COVID-19 test within last 7 days (unless overseas arrival then testing on day 1, 5 &12)
- No Masks- Other than people at airports must wear masks
- Must keep records
- Must minimise time in other jurisdictions
- Letter/documentation from employer

- COVID-19 test within last 7 days (unless overseas arrival then testing on day 1, 5 &12)
- No Masks- Other than people at airports must wear masks
- Must keep records
- Must minimise time in other jurisdictions
- Must quarantine when not working
- Letter/documentation from employer

Health Services

- Quarantine and testing as Directed by SA Health
- Must keep records
- Must wear mask when in contact with the public for 14 days
- Written approval from manager

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Specialist Workers in Essential Sectors

- COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, &12
- Mask until neg. test
- Quarantine until neg. test when not working. If the work is outside of SA or are a seasonal worker then quarantine for 14 days.
- Must keep records
- Written approval from manager

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Remote or Isolated Worker

- COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, &12
- Must wear mask when in contact with the public for 14 days
- Must keep records
- Quarantine when not working

- Must wear mask when in contact with the public
- Must keep records
- Quarantine until neg. test when not working

Urgent Medical, Dental or Health Treatment

- Must have approval from SA Health with evidence. Follow SA Health Directions.

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Cross Border Community Members 70km into VIC/SA

- Can only travel up to 70km into South Australia for essential reasons including; shopping for necessary goods/services (one person per household per day), caregiving reasons, permitted education, essential cross-border employment or providing care/support.
- COVID-19 test within last 7 days
- Must wear mask when in contact with the public
- Victorian residents must follow all other restrictions imposed by the Victorian Government

South Australian Residents Returning as a non Essential Traveller

All South Australian Residents are permitted to return home to South Australia once under this provision. The following restrictions apply:

- Low Community Transmission Zone for the previous 14 days- Nil Restrictions
- Arriving in VIC- self-quarantine for 14 days. COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12



Traveller Requirements for Entry into SA

Residents of SA travelling to VIC and then returning to SA

Residents of VIC

Passing Through

- COVID-19 test on day 1
- Self-quarantine when not travelling
- Must travel the most direct and practicable route
- Mask until neg. test
- Must have evidence of entry into the receiving state
- Can not be in SA for more than 72 hours
- Must not remain overnight or for longer than 1hr in Coober Pedy, Pt Augusta or Ceduna
- Must avoid non-essential contact with people in SA

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Compassionate Grounds

- COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12
- Must wear mask when in contact with the public for 14 days
- Quarantine when not working
- Must keep records
- Must have approval from facility with evidence

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Foreign Diplomatic or Consular Staff

- COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12
- Must wear mask when in contact with the public for 14 days
- Must keep records
- Quarantine when not working for 14 days

Not an Essential Traveller category must follow all other restrictions if in Low Community Transmission Zone for previous 14 days no restrictions. Otherwise refer to left hand columns.

Relocations, SA Returning Residents & People Escaping Domestic Violence

Permitted to enter once under this provision, must self-quarantine for 14 days and receive COVID-19 tests on day 1, 5 &12.

Any Other Traveller from Victoria

Not permitted to enter South Australia

IMPORTANT NOTE

- Former Grand Hyatt travellers and close contacts must self-quarantine for 14 days.
- Any Essential Travellers who has been in Terminal 4 of the Tullamrine Airport must quarantine when they are not performing their duties or travelling to/from their duties as an Essential Traveller.
- Household members of Melbourne Airport travellers must self quarantine when they are not performing their duties or travelling to/from their duties as an Essential Traveller until they receive a negative COVID-19 test result

*Note- A person must have been in SA or a 'Low Community Transmission Zone' (ACT, NSW, NT, QLD, TAS, VIC- other than restricted or highly restricted location, WA-) for 14 days prior to entering SA in order to enter without restrictions. A person can NOT through Melbourne airport. A person can travel through Victoria from a Low Community Transmission Zone providing they wear a face mask when in contact with the public and travel via the most direct and practicable route not stopping unless for emergency/respice/essential purposes.
