People arriving from ACT or NSW

People (including SA residents) who have been in ACT or NSW within the last 14 days	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter South Australia. SA Residents can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel. <p>NOTE: People arriving from NSW/ACT who complete supervised quarantine (as overseas arrivals) are able to transit through the airport and are now subject to Level 3 restrictions.</p>
People who are escaping Domestic Violence and people relocating who have been in ACT or NSW within the last 14 days	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Must apply to SA Health for approval of a suitable place for quarantine. Once approved, must quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
Essential Travellers having been in ACT or NSW within the last 14 days	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Essential travellers from ACT or NSW have level 4 requirements. Please refer to the Essential traveller Table for more information.
Transiting through an Airport	No Level	<p>A person is permitted to transit through an airport to get to the airport provided;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The person has travelled via the most direct and practical route. They wear a face mask for the entire time. They do not leave the airport before boarding their onward flight.
Overseas Arrivals who have completed their 14 day quarantine in NSW or ACT who immediately travel to SA any time after 5.22pm 16 July 2021	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.

People arriving from VIC

Any person who has been in Victoria within the last 14 days (excluding Permitted Arrivals and Essential Travellers) who arrives in SA after 12.00pm 17 July 2021	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter South Australia.
Permitted Arrivals and Essential Travellers who have been in been anywhere in Victoria within the last 14 days arriving in SA after 12.00pm 17 July 2021	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.

People arriving from QLD

People who have been in Greater Brisbane within the last 14 days arriving in SA after 12.01am 16 July 2021	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter South Australia. <p>NOTE: People arriving from QLD who complete supervised quarantine (as overseas arrivals) are able to transit through the airport and are not subject to any restrictions.</p>
Permitted Arrivals and Essential Travellers who have been in Greater Brisbane arriving in SA after 12.01am 16 July 2021	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
People from any other area of Queensland (including Townsville and Big Red Bash) arriving in SA after 12.01am 16 July 2021	No Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are arriving from any other area of Queensland are not subject to any restrictions upon entering South Australia.

People arriving from TAS, WA or NT

People arriving from Tasmania, Western Australia or the Northern Territory	No Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are arriving from Tasmania, Western Australia or the Northern Territory are not subject to any restrictions upon entering South Australia.

Overseas Arrivals

Unrestricted Overseas Arrivals - People arriving from New Zealand or the Cook Islands	No Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are arriving from New Zealand or the Cook Islands are not subject to any restrictions upon entering South Australia providing they have not been in any other restricted zones including overseas locations (other than New Zealand or the Cook Islands) 14 days before their arrival in South Australia.
Overseas Arrivals (other than Unrestricted Overseas Arrivals)	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine as directed. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.

- Category 1 and Category 2 Essential Travellers:** can be found in Direction.
- Permitted arrivals:** includes SA residents returning, people genuinely relocating to SA and people escaping domestic violence situations.
