It is determined that between 1 January 2017 to 21 July 2022 a total of 1722 staff sought assistance with SAPOL's Employee Assistance Program provider.

It is determined that between 1 January 2017 to 21 July 2022 a total of 354 SAPOL staff lost time from work as a result of work related mental health issues.

It is determined that between 1 January 2017 to 21 July 2022 a total of 73 SAPOL staff are not at work due to PTSD due as a result of their employment at SAPOL.
