**Re: Freedom of Information Act application**

In reference to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991, access was sought to:

*"The number and detail of security incidents for the last five years at State Government-related buildings, including the State Administration Centre, Parliament House, the Education Department and any others that come under the banner of protective security. All documents which detail the security incidents, including any incident reports. And any documents which detail any charges brought, or prosecutions, relating to the security incidents."*

On 23 August 2018, Senior Sergeant Tracy Gentgall spoke to your staff member, Lucy on the telephone to clarify the scope of your request and she confirmed that you were seeking information that relates to '*someone entering a protected place during business hours and due to their behaviour, they need to be dealt with by Protective Service Officers or South Australia Police members.*'

On 19 September 2018, I spoke to the same staff member who advised you were happy to receive a database from 2016 describing the time date and location and a brief description of the event. She also agreed to exclude all personal details.

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located a document that falls within the scope of your request. The document is numbered and described in the following schedule. The schedule contains the details of the determination in compliance with section 23. In particular, note the grounds on which access has been refused, including the reasons which are contained in the schedule.

Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

*"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."*

Clause 6(2) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

*"A document is an exempt document if it contains allegations or suggestions of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of a person (living or dead) the truth of which has not been established by judicial process and the disclosure of which would be unreasonable."*

In accordance with the requirements of Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045, details of your FOI application, and the documents to which you are given access, will be published on the SAPOL website Disclosure Log. A copy of PC045 can be found at <http://dpc.sa.gov.au/what-we-do/services-for-government/premier-and-cabinet-circulars>. If you disagree with publication, please advise the undersigned in writing by 18 October 2018.

#### Your rights to review

If you are dissatisfied with the determination for access to SAPOL records, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form (available upon request at your nearest police station), or an application may be made in writing to SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$35.00. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.
