South Australian Residents Returning as a non Essential Traveller

All South Australian Residents are permitted to return home to South Australia. The following restrictions apply:

- Low Community Transmission Zone for the previous 14 days- Nil Restrictions
- Arriving from WA Restricted Location (Peel, Perth, South West Regions), NSW Restricted Location (Greater Sydney, Central Coast, Wollongong) or VIC Restricted Location (Greater Melbourne)- COVID-19 test within 24hrs and self-quarantine until a negative test result. COVID-19 tests on days 5 & 12.
- Arriving having been at a High Risk Site in VIC- self-quarantine for 14 days. COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12
- Arriving having been at the 'Grand Hyatt Hotel in VIC on or between 12.01am 21 January and 12.01am 31 January 2021- quarantine at a medi-hotel for 14 days. COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12.

*Note- People who have been at the Grand Hyatt Hotel must quarantine at a medi-hotel for 14 days regardless of whether they are an Essential Traveller or not. A person must have been in SA or a 'Low Community Transmission Zone' (ACT, NSW- other than a restricted location, NT, QLD, TAS, VIC- other than restricted or highly restricted location, WA- other than restricted location) for 14 days prior to entering SA in order to enter without restrictions. A person can transit through Sydney, Melbourne or Perth airport and enter without restrictions providing they do not leave the airport, they are there for 2hrs or less, wear a mask and have been in a low community transmission zone for 14 days prior to entering SA. A person can travel through a Restricted NSW, VIC or WA Location from a Low Community Transmission Zone providing they wear a face mask when in contact with the public and travel via the most direct and practicable route not stopping unless for emergency/respite/essential purposes.
