National & State Security & Governance	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, or travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
Emergency Service Workers	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
Commercial Transport and Freight Services	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Category 1: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Unless they can produce evidence of a COVID-19 test or a negative COVID-19 result within the previous 7 days. Furniture removalist services must have evidence of having a COVID-19 test within the last 48hrs or must have a COVID-19 test within 24hrs of arrival and must QR Code at testing station upon entry. No self-quarantine Must not enter a high risk setting for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia. Category 2: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Unless they can produce evidence of a COVID-19 test or a negative COVID-19 result within the previous 7 days. Furniture removalist services must have evidence of having a COVID-19 test within the last 48hrs or must have a COVID-19 test within 24hrs of arrival and must QR Code at testing station upon entry. No self-quarantine Must not enter a high risk setting for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia. Employer must have a compliant risk mitigation strategies in place during the periods of work. Category 2: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Unless they can produce evidence of a COVID-19 test. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia. Employer must have a compliant risk mitigation strategies in place during the periods of work.
Cross Border Community Members 40km either side of the border between SA and VIC	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are residents of the Victorian Cross Border Corridor may enter South Australia if they have a permitted purpose to travel provided, they: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remain in the Cross Border Corridor after travelling across the border (i.e. do not travel beyond of the into another area of VIC) and Have not during the period of 14 days before entering SA from VIC corridor, been associating (in person) with people from outside of the VIC corridor or other restricted zones. Permitted purposes for travel are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Employment or education Providing care and support to or receiving care from another person or obtaining food, petrol or other fuel or medical care or supplies Obtaining a COVID-19 vaccination VIC/SA Cross Border Community Members must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receive a COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Unless they can produce evidence of a COVID-19 test or a negative COVID-19 result within the previous 7 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. Residents who travel beyond the Cross Border Corridor will need apply as a permitted arrival or Essential Traveller on return.
Specialist Workers in Essential Sectors	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, or travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia. Employer must have a compliant risk mitigation strategies in place during the periods of work.
Passing Through	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless travelling Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia. Must have evidence of entry into the receiving state. Can not be in SA for more than 72 hours Must not remain overnight or for longer than 1hr in Coober Pedy, Pt Augusta or Ceduna Must avoid non-essential contact with people in SA
Foreign Diplomatic or Consular Staff	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, or travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
