- Included in above figures are 20 posthumous awards.
- On 2 December 2020, the Governor-General declared the Bushfires 2019-20 as a nationally significant emergency for the purpose of the National Emergency Medal. Service during this nationally significant emergency is recognised through the clasp 'Bushfires 19-20'. The National Emergency Medal with Bushfires 2019-20 Clasp is awarded to a member for sustained service in the protection of lives and property, or in the service of interests that are not their own, in direct response to the declared emergency.
- The Emergency Response Active Service (ERAS) Medal is a new Level 1 Service Award that recognises
 members who have demonstrated significant sacrifice, commitment and professionalism in responding to major
 events and emergencies in South Australia. The Covid-19 ERAS Medal recognises members who worked more
 than 180 days on active service during the Covid-19 Major Emergency Declaration (22 March 2020 to 24 May
 2022). The outstanding contribution of our workforce showed tenacity and adaptability through unique and
 exceptional circumstances to maintain safer communities across the state.
- XXI Commonwealth Games Citation is awarded to SAPOL members from Special Tasks and Rescue Group Operations Section, who were deployed during the 2018 Commonwealth Games on the Gold Coast, Queensland and attended from 2 April to 16 April 2018.
