In reference to your application made pursuant to the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), access was sought to:

"The police operation manual for mobile speed guns. Not stationary or red light but mobile speed guns. Including all information on where and when they can be used. How often they have to be calibrated etc"

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located a document that falls within the scope of your request. The document is numbered and described in the following schedule. In particular, note the grounds on which access has been refused, including the reasons which are contained in the schedule.

## **CLAUSES FOR REFUSAL**

Clause 4(2)(a)(v) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to endanger the security of any building, structure or vehicle."

Clause 4(2)(b) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:

"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest."

## Your rights to review

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form, which can be downloaded from <a href="https://www.police.sa.gov.au/services-and-events/freedom-of-information">https://www.police.sa.gov.au/services-and-events/freedom-of-information</a> or available upon request at your nearest police station. Alternatively, an application may be made in writing to the SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This application must be lodged within 30 (calendar) days after you receive this letter with a fee of \$39.00, if applicable.
