WHAT IS A TRIPLE ZERO '000'
EMERGENCY?

Tips for parents/guardians

It is important to ensure your child is aware of how to call for help in an emergency. Please teach your child how to call triple zero '000' on a telephone.

Please reinforce the following tips:

- Triple zero '000' is the number you call if there is an emergency and you need police, fire or ambulance.
- You will be asked which service you require.
- If you don't know where you are do not hang up as the call can be traced.
- Stay on the line, speak clearly and answer the questions asked by the operator so they can send the help you need.
- An emergency could include if there is a car crash or someone is injured and needs help or if you feel unsafe.
- Don't hang up the phone until the operator has all of the information.
- It is free to call from any phone.
- If there is an emergency stay calm and call triple zero '000' from a safe location.
