Any Other Traveller <i>(other than those with essential traveller status)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travellers from Greater Sydney, Wollongong and Central Coast are prohibited to enter (exceptions apply to those escaping Domestic Violence situations or are relocating but self-quarantine and COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12 apply) • Travellers from the Greater Brisbane Area between 17 January and 21 January are permitted to enter but must receive three COVID-19 tests on day 1, 5 & 12. They DO NOT have to quarantine. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry from Greater Sydney, Wollongong and Central Coast permitted but they must receive a COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12, and have to self-quarantine. • Entry from Greater Brisbane is permitted but they must receive three COVID-19 tests on day 1, 5 & 12. 	

**Note- A person must have been in SA or a 'low community transmission zone' (ACT, NSW - other than the Greater Sydney, Wollongong and Central Coast, NT, QLD- other than Greater Brisbane, TAS, VIC, WA or NZ) for 14 days prior to entering SA in order to enter without restrictions. A person can transit through Brisbane or Sydney airports and enter without restrictions providing they do not leave the airport, they are there for 2hrs or less, wear a mask and have been in a low community transmission zone for 14 days prior to entering SA. A person can travel through New South Wales (without stopping in the Greater Sydney area, Wollongong or Central Coast) from a low community transmission zone providing they wear a face mask when in contact with the public and travel via the most direct and practicable route not stopping unless for emergency/respite/essential purposes.*
