Re: Freedom of Information Act application

In reference to your application made pursuant to the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), access was sought to:

"Information on how many charges for sex work offences have been laid for the 2021/22 period. Of the charges laid, please provide a breakdown of offence type.

The number of sex work related offences that have been finalised through police negotiations or by police withdrawing charges for the 2021/22 period.

How many times SAPOL used its power to enter brothels under Section 32 of the Summary Offences Act for the 2021/22 period."

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located information that falls within the scope of your request and have determined to **release in full** the information as detailed below.

In relation to this part of your request:

"Information on how many charges for sex work offences have been laid for the 2021/22 period. Of the charges laid, please provide a breakdown of offence type."

During 2021-22 five offences detected had charges laid by police in Court.

In relation to this part of your request:

"The number of sex work related offences that have been finalised through police negotiations or by police withdrawing charges for the 2021/22 period."

None. All 5 subject offences [3 defendants, 5 offences] were proved, with the defendants being found guilty and sentenced by the Court.

In relation to this part of your request:

"How many times SAPOL used its power to enter brothels under Section 32 of the Summary Offences Act for the 2021/22 period."

During 2021-22 LEB investigators utilised their authority under section 32 of the Summary Offences Act to enter and search premises suspected on reasonable grounds to be a brothel on 30 occasions.
