Re: Freedom of Information Act application

In reference to your application made pursuant to the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), access was sought to:

“Data on the number of youths and adults charged with breach of bail in 2025. Table form sufficient. The number of individuals charged with multiple charges for breach of bail in 2025 ranked by most charges to one charge only. The age of the accused in the top 20 ranked by most charges.”
