



SENIOR ROAD-USER Road Safety Sessions

Staying safe on the road is important for all drivers, however as we get older we change physically and mentally, which can affect our driving skills.

In partnership with the Motor Accident Commission, The Road Safety Section of the South Australia Police offer free road safety presentations to older road users, anywhere in the State.

Senior Road Users

(60 Minutes)

This presentation addresses issues faced by senior road users, including the increased risk of physical injury, the effects of prescription medications, night driving and alternative strategies. The session contains a road rule refresher as well as looking at the crash statistics of the 60+ age group. The 'fatal five' is also covered.

Mobility Scooters

(60 Minutes)

This presentation covers the legal requirements and the safety considerations of using motorised scooters and motorised wheelchairs on the road. The 'fatal five' is also discussed.
