Re: Application for access to South Australia Police (SAPOL) records

In reference to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991, access was sought to:

"I am seeking access to documents, specifically de-identified compensation claims by police officers since 1 May, 2019 to the date of this application. As per previous years, I am happy to be provided the information in a report format, with the following parameters:- Injury date – Accepted/Denied claim status – Physical/psychological injury type – injury mechanism description – Claim cost. Please exclude duplicates, documents that have already been publicly released, media statements/reports/articles and correspondence with media."

In our email of 25 June 2020 you were advised that Work Health Safety and Injury Management Reports, as previously disclosed in our determination dated 31 October 2015 (SAPOL FOI File number 19/0607), have not been created for the time frame specified in the scope of your application.

It is determined to **release in full** statistical data that falls within the scope of your request. The data has been presented in tables below.

Your rights to review

If you are dissatisfied with the determination for access to SAPOL records, you are entitled to exercise your right of internal review in accordance with Section 29(1) of the FOI Act by completing a PD362 Application for Internal Review form which can be downloaded from https://www.police.sa.gov.au/services-and-events/freedom-of-information or available upon request at your nearest police station. Alternatively an application may be made in writing to the SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This application must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$36.75. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.
