Re: Freedom of Information Act application

I refer to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991 in which access was sought to the following information:

It is determined to **release in full** the number of monthly fuel theft offences per suburb as reported to South Australia Police between 1 November 2016 and 31 October 2017. This data was correct as at 21 November 2017 and has been presented in a table below.

In relation to the following part of your request:

"...and the number of arrests over the period."

It is determined to **release in full** the number of fuel theft offences, as reported to South Australia Police between 1 November 2016 and 31 October 2017 that were cleared by *Arrest* and *Report*. This data was correct as at 4 December 2017 and has been presented in tables below. Care should be taken when interpreting the data sets as '*final results*' as there may still be ongoing investigations which may or may not lead to offences being cleared by *Arrest* and/or *Report*.

It should be noted that on occasions where formal action is required but the circumstances do not warrant the power of arrest to be invoked, due to the criteria for arrest not being met or not deemed necessary, the action of *reporting* the individual may occur. This action will secure the individual's appearance before a court by way of summons.
