

Additional Victorian Travel Requirements

| | Date in VIC | Requirements for entry into South Australia |

| Low Community Transmission Zone Transit through Melbourne Airport (in the airport for 2 hrs or less) | 28 January to 6 February | Permitted providing been in LCTZ for the past 14 days |
| | 7 February to 13 February (not Terminal 4 on 9th Feb) | Permitted to enter but must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quarantine until receive negative test result • COVID-19 test on days 1, 5 & 12 |
| | On or After 15 February | Permitted providing been in LCTZ for the past 14 days |
| Terminal 4 Arrivals (A person who has been in terminal 4 of Tullamarine Airport) <i>Note- This includes LCTZ people transiting through</i> | 9 February 2021 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quarantine for 14 days • COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 & 12 |
| | 10 to 12 February | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quarantine until receive negative test result • COVID-19 test on days 1, 5 & 12 |
| Household members of Terminal 4 Travellers | 9 February 2021 | Quarantine until person who was in the terminal has a negative test result. |
| Travel from Greater Melbourne | On or after 4 February | Not Permitted to Enter (exemptions apply for essential travellers) |
| Travel from Victoria | On or after 13 February | Not Permitted to Enter (exemptions apply for essential travellers) |

**Note- A person must have been in SA or a 'Low Community Transmission Zone' (ACT, NSW, NT, QLD, TAS, WA) for 14 days prior to entering SA in order to enter without restrictions. A person can travel through Victoria from a Low Community Transmission Zone providing they wear a face mask when in contact with the public and travel via the most direct and practicable route not stopping unless for*
