SAPOL has until COB on 13 July to make any further submissions and the applicant has until COB on 20 July to respond.

PASA have been requested to provide comment, more over concerns for member health and safety if cans are introduced.

If cans are introduced for liquor the expectation is it will likely flow onto soft drink cans and the like.

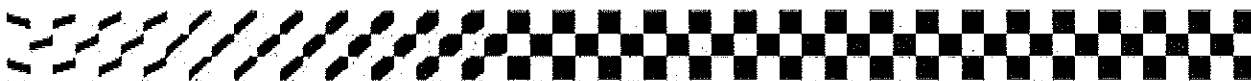
