Before dealing with your request I think it is important that I set out the processes undertaken by South Australia Police (SAPOL) in making this determination.

1. The Freedom of Information Management System (FOIMS) is a whole-of-government system that was established to provide assistance to agencies subject to the South Australian FOI Act with respect to processing and managing FOI applications;
2. FOIMS is managed by State Records of South Australia (SRSA);
3. SRSA provided consent for SAPOL to extract data from FOIMS to make this determination;
4. Data was extracted from FOIMS using the following search terms:

5. Access applications including those transferred by another agency have been extracted and included however internal reviews and other agency consultations/liaisons have been excluded;
6. Caution must be taken when interpreting the raw data in the table below. Specifically, the 'Summary' column as:
  - Text may not be the original scope verbatim;
  - FOIMS has a character limit and the original scope may not have been data entered in its entirety;
  - The scope may have been amended, clarified or narrowed;
  - The application may have been withdrawn and therefore no determination made;
7. It is important to clarify the fact that determinations made with respect to the raw data in the table below were subject to a variety of determinations and documents may have been released *in full*, released *in part* or access may have been *refused*; and
8. It should be noted that when extracted and printed, data entered apostrophes, appear as random character text (by way of example 't½??' '❖??').
