Re: Freedom of Information Act application

In reference to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991, access was sought to:

"I am seeking access to documents since 1 January, 2017, specifically reports and related CCTV/body-worn camera/video footage relating to assaults at Adelaide train stations. Please limit searches to the Southern, Northern, Eastern and Western districts. I'm specifically seeking the following information:

- The number and breakdown of assaults at train stations in these districts last financial year and this financial year to date (28/6/18 date of the application);*
- The top 10 stations where assaults occurred in these districts ie. the 10 stations where assaults occurred the most.*
- Incident reports of assaults at Adelaide Railway Station which also have footage of the assaults. Please include the related footage. If there are more than five with footage, please limit to the first five found.*

Please undertake searches chronologically, ie. from January 1, 2017 onwards. Please exclude duplicates, documents that have been publicly released, media statements/reports/articles and correspondence with media. Please note, I confirm I am happy to accept edited copies of documents with exempt material redacted."

Before dealing with your request it is important to draw your attention to the page numbers on the top right corner of each document. The page numbers relate to the number of pages printed with each batch print run and are not indicative of the number of pages associated with each report.

In relation to your request for the following:

"I am seeking access to documents since 1 January, 2017...- Incident reports of assaults at Adelaide Railway Station which also have footage of the assaults. Please include the related footage. If there are more than five with footage, please limit to the first five found."



South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located documents that are associated with the wording of your FOI application. The documents are numbered and described in the following schedule. 
