**Re: Freedom of Information Act application**

I refer to your application received by South Australia Police (SAPOL) in which access was sought to the following information:

*"I apply under the Freedom of Information Act 1991 for a copy of de-identified documents relating to protesters outside the Pregnancy Advisory Clinic. Specifically, I would like to request copies and/or records of complaints received by SA Police regarding the presence and/or behaviour of protesters outside the Pregnancy Advisory Clinic within the last 5 years (with the search end date as the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2019)."*

In our letter dated 26 August 2019 and emailed to your office on the same day, you were advised that SAPOL considered the work involved in dealing with your request would unreasonably divert our agency resources. In a bid to assist you with your application, it was suggested you amend your request to seeking access to:

*"A Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) database showing the time, date and reason for attendance of instances where SA Police were called to Pregnancy Advisory Clinic, 21 Belmore Terrace, Woodville SA 5011 for the last 3 years."*

On the same day your office replied via email, *"I can confirm that we're happy to narrow the application as detailed in your attached letter."*

It is determined to **release in full** the event number, time, date and reason with respect to SAPOL attendance at the Pregnancy Advisory Clinic, 21 Belmore Terrace, Woodville between 1 January 2016 and 30 August 2019. SAPOL attendance specifically related to complaints regarding the presence and/or behaviour of protesters. Data is contained in the table below and was correct as at 30 August 2019. This determination was made on 23 September 2019.
