**Re: Freedom of Information Act application**

I refer to your application made pursuant to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1991 in which access was sought to the following information:

*"I'm seeking documents, specifically reports, ministerial/executive briefings and attachments, audits, weapons licensing unit meeting minutes, relating to permits for weapons being granted to applicants in the past two financial years. I'm specifically looking for the number of successful applicants each year, a breakdown of age, gender, location (by LACs) and type of weapons."*

On 26 July 2018 Sergeant Friend spoke with you via telephone to clarify the scope of your request. You clarified and narrowed the scope of your request to:

*"after approvals given by SAPOL for purchase or holding of weapons as well as statistics given for firearms registrations broken down into categories."*

In response to our letter dated 7 August 2018 you further narrowed the scope of your request to:

*"statistics given for firearms registrations broken down into categories and include the first 20 applications made this year (ie from 1 January 2018) that aren't in reference to toy guns/air rifles...where permission was sought from SAPOL by Customs...limit searches to no more than 80 applications."*

**In relation to the following part of your request:**

**"statistics given for firearms registrations broken down into categories..."**

It is determined to **release in full** the statistics for 'Permit to Acquire' (PTA) a *firearm* approvals for financial years 2016/2017 and 2017/2018. This data is contained within the table below and was correct as at 1 August 2018.

**Please use caution when interpreting the data below as:**

- *The statistics do not record firearms that have been approved for purchase but are still in the process of being transferred to the new owner; it is estimated there may be approximately 650 firearms that fall within this group. As a result the 2018 statistics were correct as at 1 August 2018.*
- *The statistics do not reflect a firearm which had been registered more than once in the same period (moving from one owner to the next).*

**Further information re Category D & P:**

Due to the commencement on 1 July 2017 of the new Firearms Act 2015, some changes to firearm category and the requirement to register deactivated firearms occurred. Prior to 1 July 2017 deactivated firearms did not require registration. The majority of firearms counted in 2017/18 CAT D & P are deactivated firearms.

**Section 5 of the Firearms Act 2015** lists the categories of firearms. For your convenience I have included that section below:

**5—Categories and types of firearms**

- (1) Firearms are divided into the following categories for the purposes of this Act:
  - (a) **category A firearms** consisting of the following:
    - (i) air guns;
    - (ii) paint-ball firearms;
    - (iii) rim fire rifles (not being self-loading rifles);
    - (iv) shotguns (not being self-loading or pump action shotguns);
    - (v) break action combination shotguns and rim fire rifles;

- (b) **category B firearms** consisting of the following:
- (i) muzzle loading firearms (not being handguns);
  - (ii) revolving chamber rifles;
  - (iii) centre fire rifles (not being self-loading centre fire rifles);
  - (iv) multiple barrel centre fire rifles that are not designed to hold additional rounds in a magazine;
  - (v) break action combination shotguns and rifles (not being break action combination shotguns and rim fire rifles);
  - (vi) all other firearms (not being prescribed firearms, handguns, self-loading firearms or pump action shotguns) that are not category A firearms;
- (c) **category C firearms** consisting of the following:
- (i) self-loading rim fire rifles having a magazine capacity of 10 rounds or less;
  - (ii) self-loading shotguns having a magazine capacity of 5 rounds or less;
  - (iii) pump action shotguns having a magazine capacity of 5 rounds or less;
- (d) **category D firearms** consisting of the following:
- (i) self-loading rim fire rifles having a magazine capacity of more than 10 rounds;
  - (ii) self-loading centre fire rifles;
  - (iii) self-loading shotguns having a magazine capacity of more than 5 rounds;
  - (iv) pump action shotguns having a magazine capacity of more than 5 rounds;
- (e) **category H firearms** consisting of handguns (not being prescribed firearms);
- (f) **prescribed firearms** consisting of the following:
- (i) automatic firearms;
  - (ii) mortars, bazookas, rocket propelled grenades and similar military firearms designed to fire explosive projectiles;
  - (iii) firearms designed to fire projectiles containing tear gas or any other lacrymatory substance or any nauseating substance or poison (but not firearms designed to tranquillise, immobilise or administer vaccines or other medicines to animals);
  - (iv) firearms designed to have the appearance of other objects;
  - (v) firearms of a kind declared by the regulations to be prescribed firearms.

**In relation to the following part of your request:**

*"...include the first 20 applications made this year (ie from 1 January 2018) that aren't in reference to toy guns/air rifles...where permission was sought from SAPOL by Customs...limit searches to no more than 80 applications."*

South Australia Police (SAPOL) has located documents that are associated with the wording of your FOI application. The documents are numbered and described in the following schedule. The schedule contains the details of the determination in compliance with section 23. In particular, note the grounds on which access has been refused, including the reasons which are contained in the schedule.

Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states:


*"A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."*

Alternatively an application may be made in writing to the SAPOL Freedom of Information Unit. This application must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination with a fee of \$35.00. Such a fee may be waived in the event of an exemption being claimed.
