STOP THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

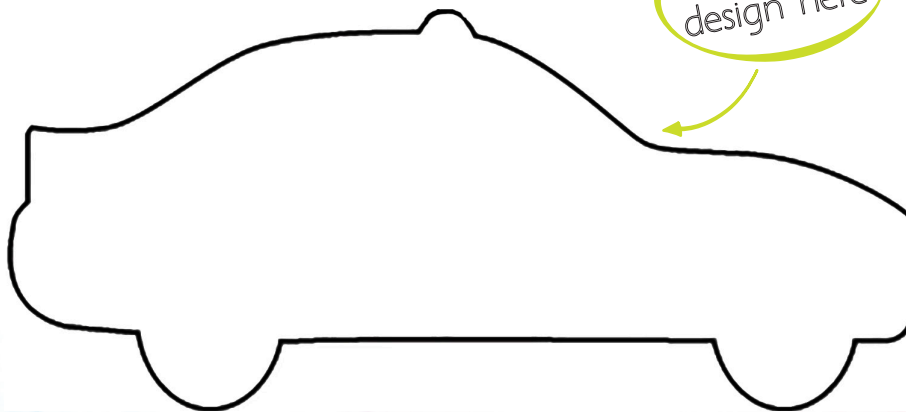

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

HOLDEN HILL CRIME PREVENTION COMPETITION 2018

1. ORGANISER

2. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By submitting an entry to the Competition, you grant SAPOL a non-exclusive, royalty free, worldwide licence to republish your Competition entry onto a car air freshener that will be distributed by SAPOL throughout the Local Service Area for purposes connected with the Competition.

3. LIMITATIONS ON ENTRY

Participants may only enter the competition once.

4. HOW TO ENTER AND SELECTION OF WINNERS

- Entrants must submit their contact details on entry form supplied.
 - Entries are to be delivered by the participating student's school to Golden Grove or Holden police station, or the school can call Holden Hill Crime Prevention Section on 8207 6025 to arrange collection.
 - Entries will be judged by Neighbourhood Watch volunteers and Holden Hill Crime Prevention Section.
 - One winner will be selected from both Categories; Category 1 Grades 3-5 and Category 2 Grades 6-7.
 - The judges' decision in relation to this competition is final and binding on every entrant. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The competition is open to the community however a relative of a judge will not be eligible to win a prize.

5. PRIZES

All prizes must be taken as offered and are not exchangeable, transferable, or redeemable for cash or for resale. Prizes unclaimed after a period of one month from the date of notification of the winner will be forfeited and used by the Organiser at the discretion of the Organiser. The two winning students will be awarded their prizes at a later date, determined by the Organiser and the winning student's school. The winning students may also have their artwork displayed for a period of time after the winners have been announced. In special situations, and subject to the absolute discretion of the Organiser, a winner may nominate a designated representative to collect a prize. Winners to be judged and finalised on 8th June 2018

6. NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS

Winners to be announced on 8th June 2018 and will be notified using the contact details listed on the entry form.

7. ENTRIES

All entries become the property of the Organiser. Entries not completed in accordance with the conditions of entry on the day of the draw (as specified above) will not be considered.
