As per s.14(4) Firearms Act, an application cannot be made by a person whose firearms licence has been previously cancelled by the Registrar under s.20(6) or (7) within 3 years of the cancellation. As per s.15(5), an application will not be granted if found guilty of a prescribed offence within previous 5 years (as listed under Schedule 2, Firearms Regulations 2017).

Submit application at a Police Station with the following:

- Company extract from Australian Securities and Investments Commission, or
- Copy of the Business Registration Certificate from Consumer and Business Services, and
- Written approval of the local council to operate a firearms dealership from the proposed premises, and
- 100 points of ID
- **Non refundable application fee**

If application is approved, Firearms Branch will contact you to discuss your proposed premises and security.
