

INTERNATIONAL VISITOR FIREARMS PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTION PAGES

These instructions apply to the application for an 'International Visitor Firearms Permit' as per Regulation 7 of the South Australia Firearms Regulations 2008.

The information contained in your application is treated as strictly confidential.

This permit applies to firearms of class A, B and H (handguns) only.

How to use these instruction pages.

There are <u>four parts</u> in the application form. <u>Parts 1 - 3 must be completed</u>. Part 4 must be completed if returning your application by surface mail.

How to complete Part 1 – Personal Information

- * Complete all sections of this Part.
- * Use the 'tab' key or mouse to move between fields.

CONFIRMATION OF FIREARMS TO BE BROUGHT INTO AUSTRALIA

How to complete Part 2 – Firearm Details

- * 'Type' should be a general description e.g. rifle, shotgun, pistol or revolver.
- * A correct serial number, appropriate to the make and model of the firearm, must be supplied. (Take care to avoid part numbers or product numbers on grips etc. **INVALID NUMBERS WILL DELAY YOUR APPLICATION**. If in doubt, seek assistance from an authorised firearms identifier).
- * Incorrect serial numbers on the firearm or permit may lead to your firearm being seized by customs.
- * If your firearm has no serial number, one will be allocated to it. The serial number must be attached to the firearm by means of a disc / key ring tag or similar or a label attached to the firearm. The tag or label must be attached prior to entry to Australia and remain attached until after the firearm leaves Australia.

How to complete Part 3 – Firearms Ammunition & Parts

- * Include all firearms ammunition and parts
- * For ammunition list quantity and calibre.
- * Do not include minor springs and screws or cleaning / maintenance tools or equipment.

How to complete Part 4 – Declaration

- * This part must be completed in the presence of a witness if returning the application by post.
- * If returning the application by email, leave this section blank.

	Firearm Classes (general information only)			
Α	Airguns; paintball firearms; .22 rim fire rifles (not semi-automatic); single or double barrel shotguns (not semi-automatic or pump action).			
В	Muzzle loading firearms (not handguns); revolving chamber rifles; centre fire rifles (not automatic or semi-automatic); any combination of shotgun and centre fire rifle.			
Н	All handguns including air pistols.			





International Visitor Permits issued for the purposes of hunting or safari trips will only be recognised within the State / Territory of issue. If you intend to hunt or compete interstate, you may need to obtain a permit for each State / Territory to be visited.

Security requirements may be different from State to State.

You will be issued an original and one copy of the International Visitors Permit. The copy may need to be handed to Customs on entry into Australia.
