WHAT IS A TRIPLE ZERO '000' EMERGENCY?

An emergency is when:

- You are feeling worried or scared that something bad is happening or you feel unsafe.
- **There is a fire.**
- **Someone has had a crash and is badly hurt, someone is very sick or you can't wake someone up.**

In an emergency you should ring triple zero '000' to get help from:



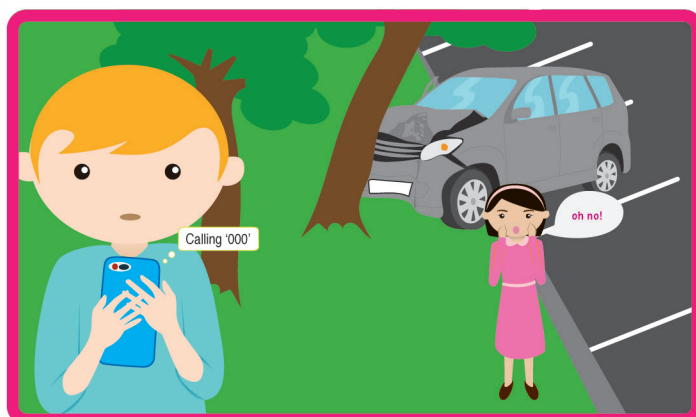
Police



Fire



Ambulance



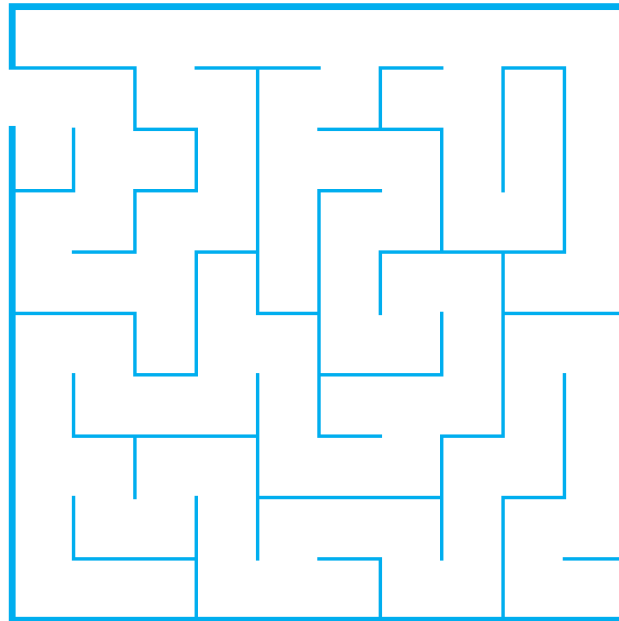
Things to remember about '000':

- it doesn't matter if you don't know where you are
- the call can be traced so you will be found
- it's a free call so you don't need money or credit on your phone to ring '000'.

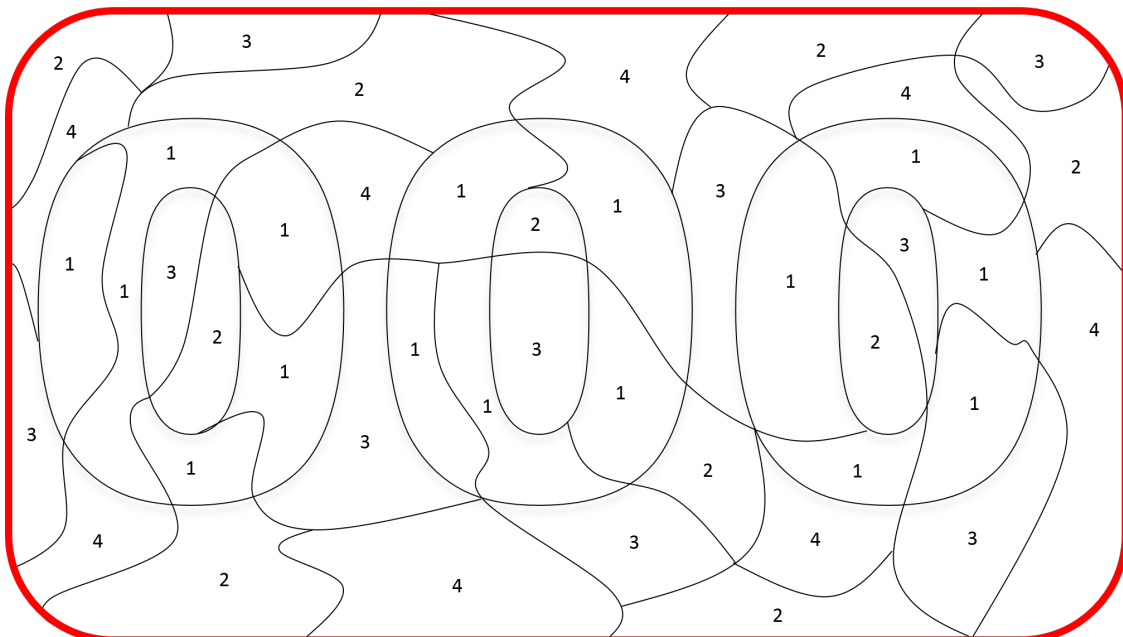


Help Road Safety

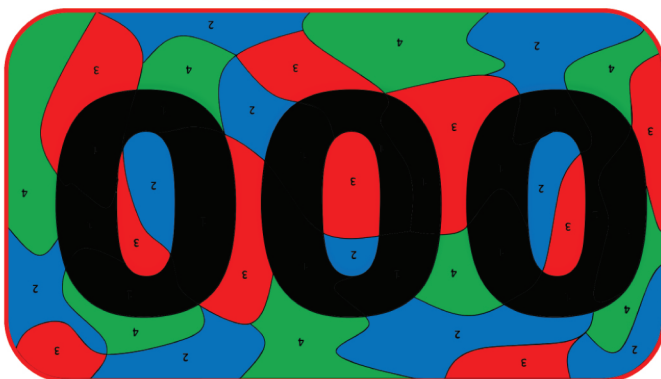
